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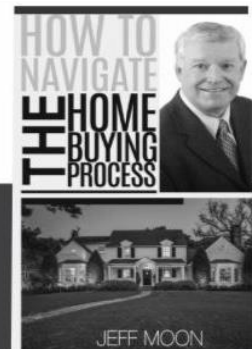
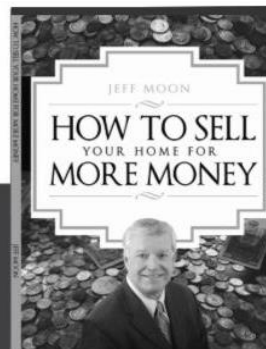
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WINE EVENT RETURNS – BACK BY POPULAR DEMAND!

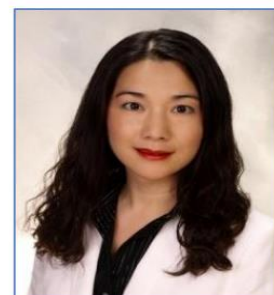

UPDATE ON STATE ELECTRIC UTILITY TAX

As the Roundup reported a few months ago, California Assembly and Senate passed AB-205 with a trailer bill that would allow electric utilities to charge customers fixed fees based on income.

Not only would this make California's income-based fixed rate highest in the nation, but also the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) would have to

implement a system to access confidential income data, normally reserved for the Internal Revenue Service and the Franchise Tax Board.

Efforts are underway by Democrats and Republicans on both sides of California's legislature to short-circuit the plan, hastily approved in 2022 in an 11th-hour proceeding and then signed by Governor Gavin Newsom.

"Too many Californians struggle to afford their electricity bills at a time when energy is already unreliable, and yet the legislature thought it was a good idea to rip people off more," state Sen. Scott Wilk (R-Santa Clarita) said in a prepared release this week.

Experts have provided an array of reasons why they believe the state PUC should reject the current proposal; otherwise, efficiency and frugality would be penalized and inefficiency and waste rewarded.

"Our constituents have had enough and so have we," said Assemblymember Jacqui Irwin (D-Thousand Oaks). "It's time to put some reasoning back into how we charge for electricity in California." ... Stay tuned.

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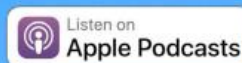

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FREE 2024 TAX PREPARATION SERVICES AVAILABLE IN IRVINE

The City of Irvine, in partnership with Orange County United Way, is offering free tax preparation services to taxpayers who earned less than \$60,000 in 2023. Qualifying taxpayers who live, work, or attend school in Irvine can receive help filing taxes from IRS-trained and certified volunteers, who will also assist eligible taxpayers in applying for tax credits, including the state and federal Earned Income Tax Credits (EITC).

The OC Free Tax Prep service is available at Harvard Community Center, 14701 Harvard Ave. in Irvine, from January 30 through April 16, Tuesdays, noon–7:30 p.m. An appointment is required; no walk-ins will be accepted. Call Orange County United Way at 888-434-8248 for more information on EITC cash-back credits, and to schedule an appointment.

Taxpayers with internet access can choose to file their own federal and state tax returns online for free, if eligible. For more information, visit OCFreeTaxPrep.com.

Part of this free filing service will include advising taxpayers on potential credits. The expanded California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC), along with a similar federal credit, can provide additional funds back to workers when they file their taxes. Additionally, workers with children under age 6 may qualify for the Young Child Tax Credit, if they are working and their household income is less than \$58,000.

To prepare, bring copies of:

- Photo Identification for you and your spouse (if applicable).
- Social Security Card or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) letter for all individuals listed on the return.
- W-2s, 1099s, and all other income-related documents for 2022.
- Form 1095-A, B, or C health insurance coverage statement for state return.
- All 1098-T and E forms for education expenses.
- Childcare provider name, address, phone number, and Tax ID number.
- Record of Middle Class Tax Refund and any other stimulus checks.
- Accounting and routing number if you want your refund direct deposited (recommended).
- Copy of your last year's tax return (recommended).
- For joint returns, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms.

SCAM PREVENTION

We are inundated with information from phone calls, texts, emails, and social media. The types of scams change all the time. However, they do have recurring patterns.

Some red flags to look for include scammers often using urgency and fear by pressuring you to make quick decisions without letting you think clearly.

On the flip side they may lure you by saying you won a prize or they need help with a problem. They may impersonate your friends or family or pretend to be legitimate businesses or government agencies requesting your personal information or some form of payment.

Tech support scams lure you into clicking on malicious links or downloads to steal your information or access your computers. Romance scams are common; they build relationships and pull on your heartstrings, manipulating victims into sending gifts or money. Investment scams promise high returns with little risk in cryptocurrencies or unregulated markets. Work-from-home scams ask for money upfront.

This can be overwhelming; here are some tips to help avoid being scammed:

- Don't share your personal information unless you initiate the transaction with a verified person/business.
- Resist the pressure to act immediately.
- Keep tabs on all of your accounts and use complex passwords.
- Talk to someone about your transactions before exchanging information or payments.

Remember, if it sounds too good to be true, it probably is! Always err on the side of caution and read the small print before providing personal information.

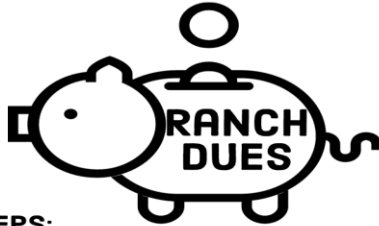
